Full-Time Programs:

Auto Collision, Auto Service Technician, Barbering, Certified Nursing Assistant, Certified Production Technician, CNC Machining, Cosmetology, Electrical(Residential + Commercial), Electro Mechanical Maintenance, HVAC, Hotel Front Desk, Licensed Practical Nurse, Medical Billing Clerk, Medical Office Assistant, Phlebotomy, Welding.

Part Time Programs:

Accounting, Animal Care, Automotive Services, Building Trades, Computer Aided Design, Electricity/Electronics, Health and Medical, Heavy Equipment Operator, HVAC, Industrial Maintenance, Welding.

Affordable Tuition and Financial Assistance:

On average, Erie 1 BOCES' job training tuition costs 50% less than similar programs offered by local colleges. Students may be eligible to receive funding through: ACCES-VR, Buffalo Employment and Training Center (BETC), CSEA, ECC One Stop, Niagara Employment and Training, SEIU Local 1199, and Veterans Benefits. Various State and Federal grants are also available as well as Direct or Private Student Loans.

Student Services:

Erie 1 BOCES supports its students successful transition into permanent employment in the following ways: Career Counseling, Job Readiness Training, Resume Writing Workshops, Interview Preparation, Job Placement.

Literacy Services:

Erie 1 BOCES offers High School Equivalency and ESL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) courses across Western New York. Remedial courses are available for students who need support in Math or English. Call for more information (716) 821-7375.
