Military and the Law

Bri Dussault is a senior from Tonawanda Senior High School and is enrolled in the Criminal Justice program at Erie 1 BOCES Kenton Career and Technical Education Center.

"I enrolled in BOCES because I took a great interest in criminal justice and law," said Bri. "This program has given me more knowledge about the military and other jobs within the criminal justice system. It's taught me the basics of the American system of justice and prepared me for college."

In the fall of 2024, following graduation, Bri is thinking about going into the Air Force Reserves and college. "But I'm not 100% set in my major," she said.

Under the instruction of John Manth, Bri has explored the major areas of the field, including law enforcement, courts, corrections, investigations and forensics, homeland security, private security and more.

"Bri has a 98 average and is a leader in my class," said Manth. "She recently was the judge in our mock trial. She is an outstanding student!"

"Mr. Manth's class has greatly increased my ability to communicate," said Bri. "I am a better reader, writer and communicator because of the way he teaches the class and the projects he has us complete. I also have developed very good research skills!"

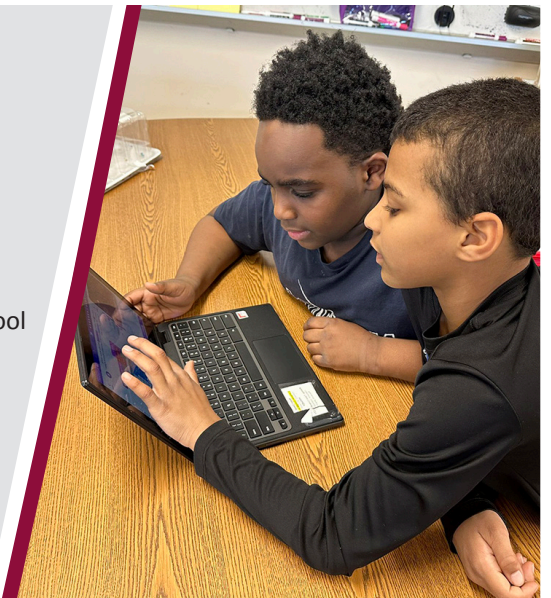
“This program has helped me academically and socially,” said Adam.
